Key figures

At **Santíssima Trinitat School**, we cultivate an inclusive and vibrant educational community, providing both Secondary Education and Vocational Training programs. Here is an overview of our key figures for the 2023–2024 academic year:

Secondary Education:

- **8 groups of ESO** (*Compulsory Secondary Education*)
- **4 groups of Batxillerat** (*High School*)
- Total students: **360** (*229 ESO + 131 Batxillerat*)

Vocational Training:

- **3 groups of CFGM** (*Intermediate Vocational Training*)
- **2 groups of CFGS** (*Advanced Vocational Training*)
- Total students: **129** (*80 CFGM + 49 CFGS*)

Our team is made up of 42 committed educators who deliver high-quality instruction across all areas of study.

These numbers reflect our dedication to offering a well-rounded education that equips students for success in both their academic journeys and future careers.

Meet our team

Our team supports students throughout their educational journey, using active learning strategies such as project-based learning and flipped classrooms. These approaches help students develop a solid theoretical foundation while gaining practical, hands-on experience.

The leadership team plays a key role in defining the school's direction, focusing on long-term goals and ensuring that everyday practices reflect our core values of inclusion and excellence. They oversee the implementation of the School Pedagogical Plan, which prioritizes academic rigor and individualized learning pathways.

We are dedicated to academic excellence, especially in the areas of science, technology, and foreign languages. To strengthen language skills and global awareness, we offer specialized programs such as CLIL (Content and Language Integrated Learning).

Vocational education is also a central pillar of our school, with robust training programs closely linked to both local and international companies. These initiatives prepare students for real-world careers. Through the Erasmus+ program, students and staff enjoy international exchange opportunities, while the school also fosters social responsibility and environmental awareness through sustainability projects and green education.

2. Academic programmes



Here you can read is a brief summary on our courses and what our students are focused on each of these:

- **CFGM Nursing Care Assistance.** The CFGM Nursing care assistance is a vocational program that prepares students to support patient care in healthcare settings. It teaches essential skills like hygiene, supervised medication administration, and medical preparation. Graduates are qualified to work as nursing assistants, helping medical staff and contributing to community health.
- **CFGM Administrative Management.** The vocational training program in Administrative Management prepares students to carry out administrative operations in both the public and private sectors, in accordance with internal organizational regulations and current legislation, efficiently and with a high standard of service quality.
- **CFGS Administration and Finance.** The Higher Vocational Training Program prepares students to handle various types of documents in companies of any sector and size, in accordance with the organization's goals, established internal regulations, and current legislation.

Graduates will be able to assist in personnel administration and management, carry out accounting operations, and manage information and customer or client support, both in the public and private sectors.
